The Institute of Physics seeks strong candidates with academic experience abroad who can contribute to the excellence and diversity of the Institute community through compelling research, teaching at undergraduate and graduate levels, and administrative duties.

The successful candidate is expected to have an excellent background in both disciplines, Physics and Mathematics. We welcome strong candidates from all areas of Mathematical Physics with preference for those with potential interaction with the established research areas at the Institute such as Spectral Theory, Quantum Physics, and Non-linear Physics.

The candidate should be able to teach a variety of standard undergraduate and graduate physics courses. The ability to teach in English and Spanish is expected after one year.

Applications must include:

- Curriculum vitae,
- List of publications in refereed journals,
- Statement of past research achievements and future research plan,
- Statement of teaching interests at undergraduate and graduate levels,
- Two recommendation letters sent directly by the recommenders.
